

JAIL PHYSICIAN

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: Performs professional medical services as a part-time physician at the County Correctional Facility on twenty-four hour call; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is responsible professional work calling for the services of an experienced physician. The need for medical services is pointed out and reports may be reviewed by the appropriate authority, but methods or execution are left to the discretion of the physician. The position carries no supervisory responsibility.

EXAMPLES OF WORK:

- Examines, re-examines and treats patients at the County Correctional Facility or at a health care facility when patient is admitted;
- Performs regular physical examinations on correctional facility employees;
- Prepares reports of examinations made;
- Responds to sheriff's calls to supply medical attention to the prisoners injured.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of the principles and practices of medicine; ability to get along well with others; conscientiousness and thoroughness; interest in maintaining a high standard of public service; good professional judgment; good physical condition.

ACCEPTABLE EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

Two years of experience as a physician or surgeon AND graduation from a school of medicine or recognized standing; or any equivalent combination of experience and training sufficient to indicate ability to do the work.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS:

Possession of a license to practice medicine in New York State.
