

CONSTRUCTION WORKER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This position exists in a village Public Works Department and involves responsibility for performing a variety of semi-skilled and manual labor duties in construction and repair projects. The work is performed under the general supervision of a higher ranking employee. The incumbent does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Participates in the construction and repair of streets, structures, buildings;
- Mops brushes or spreads paint or compounds over surfaces for protection;
- Mixes, pours and spreads concrete, asphalt, gravel and other materials;
- Performs a variety of tasks involving the use of hand tools such as sawing, dismantling forms, mounting pipe hangers;
- Positions and secures steel bars in concrete forms to reinforce concrete;
- Cuts bars to required lengths using hacksaw, bar cutters and acetylene torch;
- Assembles, installs and repairs pipes, fittings and fixtures of heating, water and drainage systems;
- Installs and repairs plumbing fixtures such as sinks, commodes, bathtubs, water heaters;
- Positions, joins, aligns and seals pipe connections;
- Performs routine manual laboring duties.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of the principles and practices of a construction trade; good knowledge of carpentry, masonry, and plumbing; good knowledge of the methods, tools and materials used in construction and repair projects; skill in the use of tools and equipment used in the construction trades; ability to read and understand building plans and blueprints; ability to work well with others; willingness to perform work requiring strenuous effort; willingness to be exposed to dust, dirt and grime; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either -

(A) One year of experience in one or more of the construction trades such as carpentry, plumbing and masonry;

OR (B) Two years of experience in general construction work;

OR (C) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (A) and (B) above.
