

SKI AREA MANAGER

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: Has charge of the year round operation of the Town of Webb ski center; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is a supervisory position involving responsibility for the operation, repair and maintenance of facilities at the Town of Webb ski area. During the summer the center is open for chair lift rides. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Town Board. Supervision is exercised over all employees of the ski area.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

- Supervises the day to day operation and maintenance of the ski area;
- Inspects and has charge of the resurfacing of slope and trails;
- Plans and directs the maintenance and care of ski slopes, turf, trees and shrubs;
- Oversees the work of all ski area personnel;
- Inspects facility for safety and efficiency;
- Prepares operating, financial and accident reports.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Good knowledge of general operating methods of a ski area; good knowledge of tools and equipment used in maintaining ski slopes including ski and tow machinery and rollers; ability to plan and supervise the work of others; working knowledge of landscaping and grounds keeping as it applies to the maintenance and care of ski slopes and trails; ability to make minor mechanical repairs; reliability; good physical condition.

ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Four years of experience in either general maintenance, construction or building trades work, two years of which must have involved responsibility for supervising the work of others; or any equivalent combination of training and experience.
