### **Transportation**

Transportation is available to get you where you need to go within Herkimer County such as:

grocery store bank

post office hairdresser



- Try to call at least a week in advance to be placed on the schedule for a ride.
- The vans are curbside to curbside service.
   This means that you must be able to get yourself in and out of the vehicle.
- The vans are wheelchair accessible. Let our scheduler know if you

need the lift so we can allow extra time. All riders must provide and wear a wheelchair waist safety harness at all times while riding.

- You can arrange for a pickup time with the driver when you are dropped off.
- Or, when done with your appointment call the OFA office at 315-867-1121.
