Sealed proposals will be received by the County of Herkimer, New York, until 10:00 A.M., at the Prevailing time on May 15, 2025 at the Office of the Department of Highways, 313 Third Avenue, Herkimer New York, for the Rehabilitation of Bridge Street (CR 200) and Old State Road (CR 200), situated in the Town and Village of Newport, Herkimer County, New York. All bids received pursuant to this notice will be publicly opened and read aloud at the office of the Department of Highways at 10:00 A.M. on May 15, 2025.

Sealed bids must be plainly marked with:

“Sealed Bid – Rehabilitation of Bridge Street (CR 200) and Old State Road (CR 200)”

Copies of the Contract Documents are on file at the Herkimer County Highway Department, 313 Third Avenue, Herkimer, NY 13350 and may be examined, at no expense, between the hours of 8:00 am -12:00pm and 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm local time Monday through Friday.

A deposit of check/money order made payable to County of Herkimer or by credit card via phone/online/in person (credit card fees apply) in the amount of \$50.00 must be received prior to issuance of documents. No refund will be made.

Contractors must obtain Contract Documents from the issuing office to be placed on the Official Plan Holder List in order to receive addenda and any other bid correspondence. Bids received from Contractors not on the Official Plan Holder List will not be accepted.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 5 percent (5%) of the gross amount of the bid.

The bidder to whom the Contract is awarded will be required to furnish performance, payment, and guarantee bonds from an acceptable Surety Company for an amount not less than 100% of the accepted bid.

This project is subject to the provision of Chapter 605, Laws of the State of New York of 1959, Section 103-A of The General Municipal Law and subsequent amendments.
